

# Keyport Music Festival 2020 Postponed

Keyport Music Festival 2020 will be rescheduled to October 9, 2021, the Keyport Bayfront Business Cooperative (KBBC) has announced. The bluegrass, jazz, and blues festival has quickly become a must-attend event after its first two highly successful seasons. However, the combination of large attendance and a variety of small venues has made staging the event this year too great a risk for artists, patrons, staff, and the community, so KBBC has made the difficult decision to bypass the festival this year.

The 2021 festival will feature the same combination of bluegrass, jazz, and blues which has already made it such a popular event in the Bayshore and beyond. In 2021 we hope to welcome back last year's headliners Tony Trischka, Deadgrass, and Jay Unger & Molly Mason.

The *Asbury Park Press* may have summed it up best with their review after the inaugural Keyport Music Festival in 2018:

*“We heard great acts all afternoon and evening, all within easy walking distance of each other, and beer, food, and other refreshments were reasonably priced... Patrons were not confined to an all-too-restrictive “beer and wine garden” as they often are at outdoor festivals, and they could walk to venues with beer in hand across four blocks along West Front Street.”*

The Keyport Music Festival is presented by KBBC, the Business Improvement District for the Borough of Keyport, and funding is provided by commercial property owners and businesses in Keyport.

Although the festival will not be held this October, please visit Keyport this fall to support the many shops and businesses that make the Keyport Music Festival possible.
